

## **REDDITCH GOLF CLUB DRESS CODE**

Redditch Golf Club aims to operate a contemporary and forward-thinking dress policy which is appropriate for a modern-day members' club. It is in all our interests to maintain reasonable standards of casual but smart dress in keeping with golfing traditions whilst at the same time ensuring that the clubhouse is a welcoming place for members, their families and their guests.

Members of Redditch Golf Club are therefore made aware that the following are required standards that must be adhered to both on the golf course and in the clubhouse. Members should ensure that their guests are aware of this dress code.

### **On the course**

Golfing attire is required for all players. Denim jeans, tracksuits, t-shirts, sleeveless shirts (men only), cargo or combat trousers, rugby shirts, football shirts and trainers are not permitted on the course at any time.

Gentlemen's shirts should be tucked in at all times. It is understood that during play shirts can become untucked but please try to stay 'tucked in'. Ladies' shirts may be worn outside other clothing if designed to be worn in this way.

### **In the clubhouse**

Tracksuits, t-shirts, sleeveless shirts (men only), cargo or combat trousers, rugby shirts, football shirts and trainers are not permitted in the clubhouse at any time.

'Crossover' footwear, specifically designed for both on-course and off-course wear, is acceptable but please ensure that such footwear is clean before entering the clubhouse.

Smart denim jeans are permitted within the clubhouse and its immediate vicinity but only if they are clean, are of uniform colour and are free of any fraying, holes, rips or tears.

Hats / caps and dirty, muddy or wet clothing are not permitted in the bar areas.

In addition, members and their guests are expected to observe any, more formal, dress code requirements at particular Club functions, details of which will be publicised fully beforehand.
